

By Law 22

Women's Auxiliaries

1. Each State Branch may form within its jurisdiction such Women's Auxiliaries as it may consider necessary or desirable.
2. **Constitution and Rules.** The Constitution and Rules of each Women's Auxiliary shall be approved by the State and no alteration shall be made thereto unless the same shall have been approved in writing beforehand by the State Branch.
3. **Statement of Purposes of the State Auxiliary.** The objects for which the Auxiliary is established are:
 - a. to unite Women's Auxiliaries of RSL Sub Branches throughout Tasmania or any other related Auxiliary to achieve those ideals for which the RSL and its Auxiliaries stand: and
 - b. to render service to the RSL and its members, to give physical and financial assistance to activities devoted to the welfare of Tasmanian serving and ex-service men and women and their dependants, wherever they may be.
4. **Powers of the Branch.** The State Executive of the Auxiliary shall be subject to direction from the RSL (Tasmania) State Executive (hereinafter referred to as the Branch) in all matters, but within this principle, shall be governed by the Annual General Meeting (hereinafter referred to as the Annual Conference) of Auxiliary members which shall be held at such time and place as the Auxiliaries may decide. The State Branch and/or the Executive of the Women's Auxiliary may suspend or dissolve an Auxiliary if in its opinion a continuance of the existence of the Auxiliary is not in the best interest of the Sub Branch or the League.
5. **Composition.** The Auxiliary shall consist of RSL Sub Branch Auxiliaries or any other similar Auxiliary throughout Tasmania that has applied and been accepted for affiliation with the Auxiliary, and has paid the required affiliation fee as fixed by the Annual Conference of the Auxiliary.
6. **Administration.** The Auxiliary shall be responsible for its own administration as determined by the Annual Conference. Between Conferences, the Auxiliary State Executive shall administer the Auxiliary. Neither the Auxiliary nor the Annual Conference may direct or interfere with the domestic working of any Sub Branch Auxiliary so long as it confirms to the aims, objects and policy of the Auxiliary.
7. **Policy.** The Policy of the Auxiliary shall be non-sectarian and in relation to the questions of party politics, non partisan.
8. Auxiliaries formed by RSL Sub Branches must be approved by State Branch and affiliated with the State RSL Women's Auxiliary.
