Nomination Criterion for Sub Branch Executive and Committee Positions

1. Pursuant to Rule 24 of the Sub Branch Constitution, to nominate for a position on the Committee of a Sub Branch of the Returned & Services League of Australia (Tasmania Branch) Inc. the nominee must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Be a financial Service, Life, Affiliate or Social Member of the Sub Branch. The nominator and seconder must also be financial.
 - b. Be of good reputation and character in that he/she:
 - (i) Not be a declared Bankrupt;
 - (ii) Must not be named on the ASIC Banned and Disqualified Directors Register
 - (iii) Not have a conviction under Criminal Law, or any other conviction which resulted from unacceptable behaviour which was not in accordance with RSL Tasmania Branch By Laws and policies.
 - (iv) Not have been found guilty of any offence pursuant to Rule 17 of the Sub Branch Constitution, or Rule 12 or Rule 13 of the State Branch Constitution, within the past five years;
 - c. Have no medical impairment which would prevent the member from carrying out his duties in what could at times, be a stressful role and could regularly involve in excess of ten (10) hours commitment per week.
 - d. Is not eligible without special dispensation from the majority of committee if he/she has resigned from a committee position within the last 12 months for any reason other than medical.
 - e. Have a sound knowledge of the workings of the RSL and its Constitutions;
 - f. Preferably, have previous relevant business knowledge and experience;
 - g. Willingly accept the roles and responsibilities of an Executive Officer of the RSL Sub Branch in accordance with the Constitution;
 - h. Provide a short biography and photograph; and
 - i. Provide an outline of their views for the future direction of the RSL Sub Branch.
